I was lucky enough to grow in a family and an environment where true equality was a fact. The girls who were my school colleagues seemed often smarter and more committed to hard work than the boys, who were often more superficial. In my first job, one of the owners, and in fact the one holding the place together was a woman. Yes, I met a few misogynists, but I always thought they are just awkward guys whom no one would take seriously. Unfortunately, it was only much later and only when reaching abroad and into higher circles when I realized the world is less gender balanced than I thought. And yes, there are circles where women still need ambassadors. Where status quo needs to be changed.

So, I was happy to help a bit. And am grateful to be considered a man-bassador. It is for me part of a broader system of building this world into a better place. And building this business world into a more normal, caring and balanced network. It is about gender diversity, broader diversity, inclusion, helping others, accepting our limits and growing together into better people.

> Call to action

I am still surprised every time when I see discrimination, because it feels so obsolete. Like an unpaved road in the middle of the city, it makes you feel... dusty. Sometimes it is imposed, but sometimes it even comes from within, as complacency. It could even be embedded culturally, as we still don't have enough female business mythology, enough role models. So we need to set the dust and pave the roads. Create those success stories and tell them. And build the world that we would like to live in. Where our girls and boys are able to fully express who they are, and contribute to an even better world. In this part of the world, this should be simple, upholding unity and diversity, for an evolving civilization.
